Breuner Marsh Restoration and Public Access Project

Point Pinole Regional Shoreline
Richmond, California

The project will restore coastal habitat and provide for public access in a 150-acre area. Approximately 30 acres of wetlands and 50 acres of coastal scrub/prairie will be restored. A critical 1.5 mile gap in the San Francisco Bay Trail will be constructed in the project area. Public parking, restrooms, trails, picnic facilities and interpretive exhibits will also be developed.

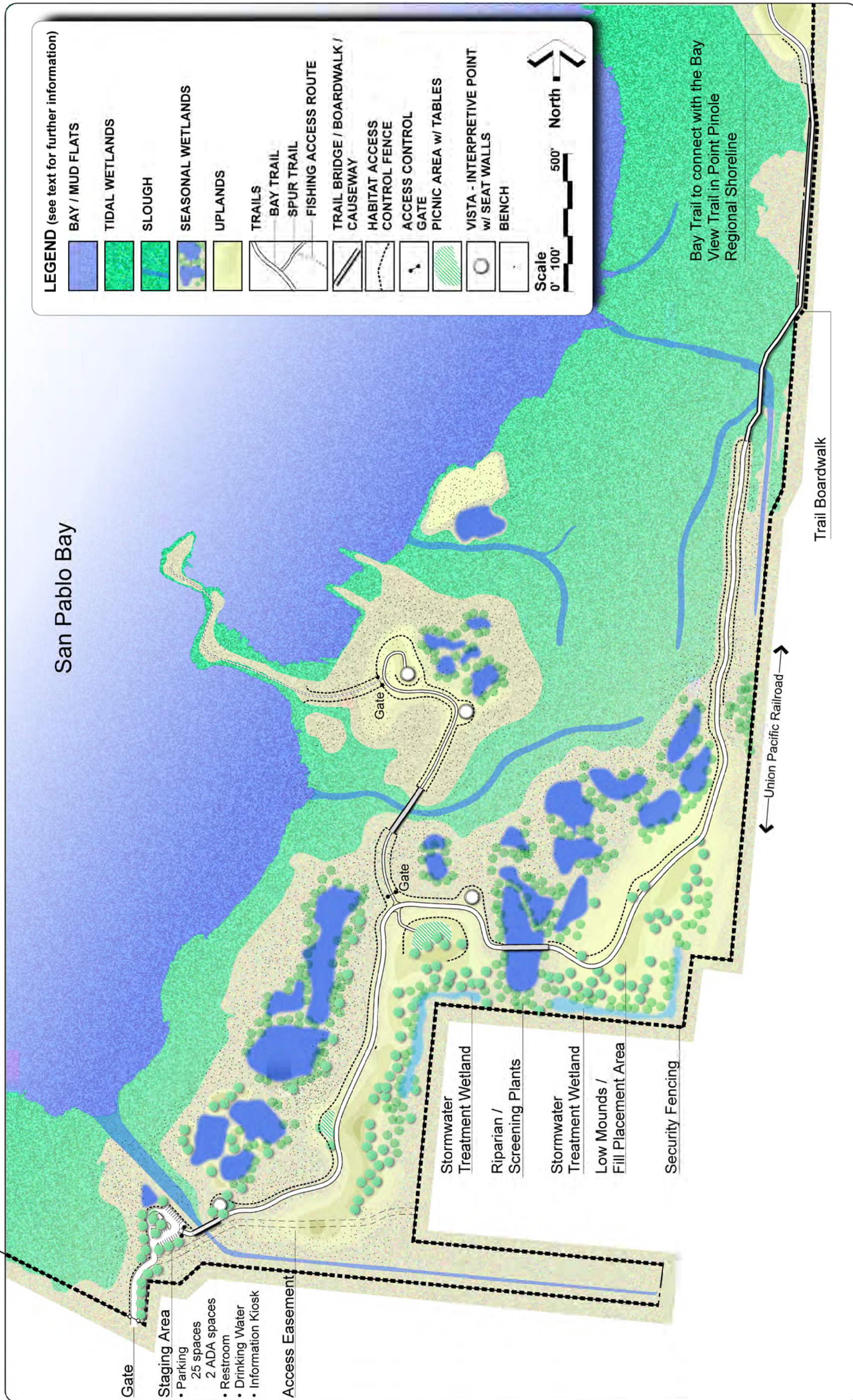
The property was acquired in order to protect its scenic open space values, to restore habitats for endangered species and to provide for improved access to San Francisco Bay.

Public meetings are underway and an EIR is being prepared. Construction of phase one is planned for 2013 followed by phase two in 2015. The total project is estimated to cost \$8,000,000. Thus far, \$2,000,000 has been obtained from the Castro Cove Trustees and the US Fish and Wildlife Service.
