FIELD TRIP BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The East Bay Regional Park District Board of Directors has scheduled a field trip to commence at **9:30 a.m. on Friday, June 10, 2011**, at EBRPD Administrative Office, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California. The Board field trip will include stops at Black Diamond Regional Preserve and Concord Naval Weapons Station. It is anticipated that the group will return at approximately 4:00 p.m.

*** All participants will be riding in EBRPD vehicles while touring properties.**

**** Due to Concord Naval Weapons Station security requirements, all attendees visiting the CNWS must provide their name as written on their driver's license (DL), DL number, and the DL expiration date via phone (510) 544-2510 or fax (510) 569-1432 no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 6, 2011. Attendees must have DL on person while on tour of the Concord Naval Weapons Station.**

***Depart Peralta Oaks 9:30 a.m.**
(Anyone planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks should arrive no later than 9:15 a.m.)

Arrive Junction of Kirker Pass and Nortonville Road 10:10 a.m.

Take I-580 W. Merge onto CA-13/Warren Freeway to CA-24 E toward Walnut Creek/Concord. Keep left at the fork, follow signs and merge onto I-680 N/Sacramento/Concord. Take the Ygnacio Valley Road exit. Turn right onto Ygnacio Valley Road. Ygnacio Valley Road becomes Kirker Pass Road. Continue on to the junction of Nortonville Road (on the right).

Tour Former Land Waste Management & Barron Properties 10:15 a.m.

The Board will be touring the former Land Waste Management parcel located between Concord and Pittsburg and bisected by Kirker Pass Road. They will also view the Barron land bank property with an overview of Irish Canyon and the Ang Land Bank in Black Diamond Regional Preserve. We will exit through Clayton Ranch on Marsh Creek Road, opposite Diablo Valley Ranch. The group will be driving through vast acreage with open grassland and Blue Oak woodlands. Actual route may be modified due to road conditions.

Arrive at the Planned New Regional Park at the Former Concord Naval Weapons Station (Inland Area)

1:30 p.m.

The Board will be visiting the site of the planned new Regional Park on the inland portion of the former Concord Naval Weapons Station.

Note: There will be a security check in for all attendees on Port Chicago Highway.

Start out going east on Center Street in city of Clayton toward Marsh Creek Road. Turn left onto Marsh Creek Road. Turn left onto Clayton Road. Turn right onto Farm Bureau. Farm Bureau Road becomes E. Olivera Road. Turn right onto Port Chicago Highway. 5100 Port Chicago Highway is on the right. Meet at the entrance of the base (north of Highway 4, just past the golf course) in the main parking lot of the CNWS. It is now called the **Military Ocean Terminal – Concord or MOTCO.**
